PROBUS CLUB OF HUNTERS HILL AND DISTRICT

Management Committee

PURPOSE:

To manage the affairs of the Club, between meetings and further, as required by the general membership by decisions taken from time to time, and keeping the best interests of the Club at all times

Note: Clause 4 of the Constitution provides in part:

- a. The Club shall be managed by a Management Committee, comprising a President, one or more vice-Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer (collectively "Committee Members"), and such number of other members of the Management Committee ("Officers") as provided in the By-laws or the Club's Standing Resolutions.
- b. Officers and Committee Members shall be elected annually in accordance with the By-laws or the Club's Standing Resolutions. The term of office of the President shall be one year, which may be extended to not more that two consecutive years if required due to special circumstances. Other Officers and Committee members may serve for not more than three successive years in any one office except as otherwise determined and recommended by the Management Committee to members for decision.

Clause 2, sub-clause a. states:

a. The Management Committee shall comprise:

President
Vice President
Secretary/Public Officer
Treasurer
Activities Director
Four (4) Committee Members

Ex-officio Officer who is the Immediate Past President.

(The original constitution of 3rd February 1976, provided for a management committee of seven members, comprising the President, Vice President, Honorary Secretary, Honorary Treasurer, two ordinary members and the immediate past President as an ex-officio member for one year. It also provided for the election of a new President each year.)
